MDA's services include providing first aid and emergency medicine, collecting blood donations, offering training activities, and supplying humanitarian aid to the community.

Israel is in constant need of medical personnel, especially physicians, who can respond quickly and efficiently to the needs of Israeli citizens in case of emergency or mass casualty. 'Doctors for Magen David Adom' is a great program that trains and connects doctors from around the world with Israel.

The seminar will include:

- Informative lectures about the history of MDA and its role in Israeli society today.
- How to respond to mass casualty events.
- Disaster preparedness, such as earthquakes.
- Meeting with senior MDA staff as well as volunteers.
- Meeting with Israeli physicians.
- A tour of MDA facilities: National Dispatch Center, National Blood Bank and National School for Paramedics.
- A compulsory workshop volunteering at a MDA station or on an ambulance.
- A follow up course on how to teach what you have learned in your own community or country.
